We are pleased to announce that the Association is organizing a 3.5-hour workshop, entitled ‘有教無「戾」校園欺「零」計畫 (Project C.A.R.E.): Rationale & Practices (Part 2)’ on 24 April, 2010. The director of the project, Dr. Annis FUNG Lai-chu (馮麗姝博士), who conducted Part 1 of the workshop focusing on tackling the school bullies last June, and her assistant will be the workshop facilitators. **With the emphasis on handling bully victims, this workshop (Part 2)** is to complete the essentials of what guidance teachers need to know about combating school bullying.

Project C.A.R.E.  (Children and Adolescents at Risk Education) was funded by the Quality Education Fund and commissioned by Hong Kong Christian Service. The project, having its underpinnings on scientific evidence-based research, takes on the Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) approach.
