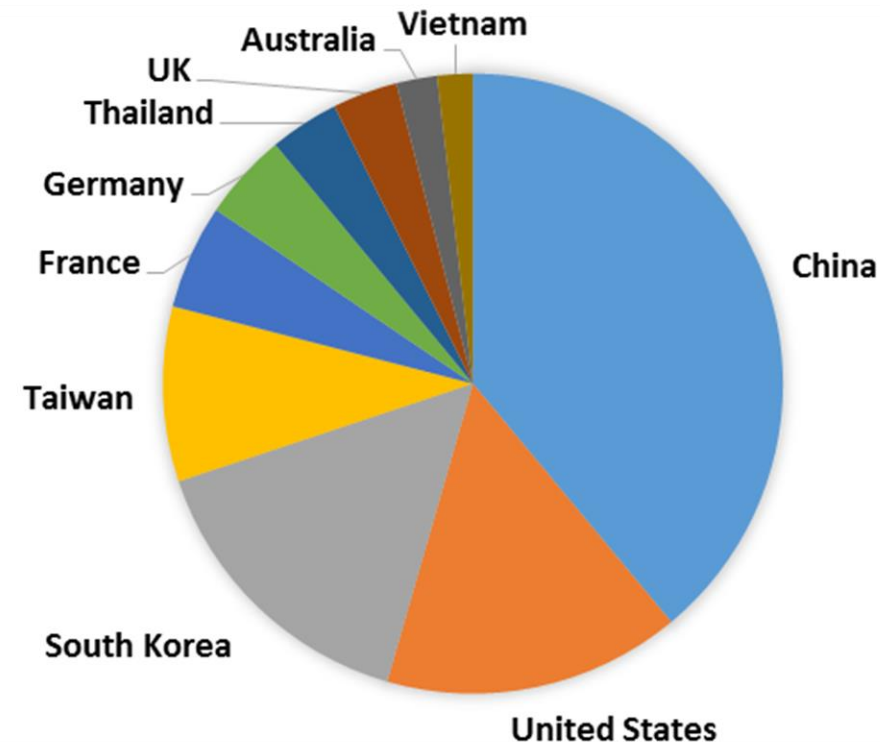

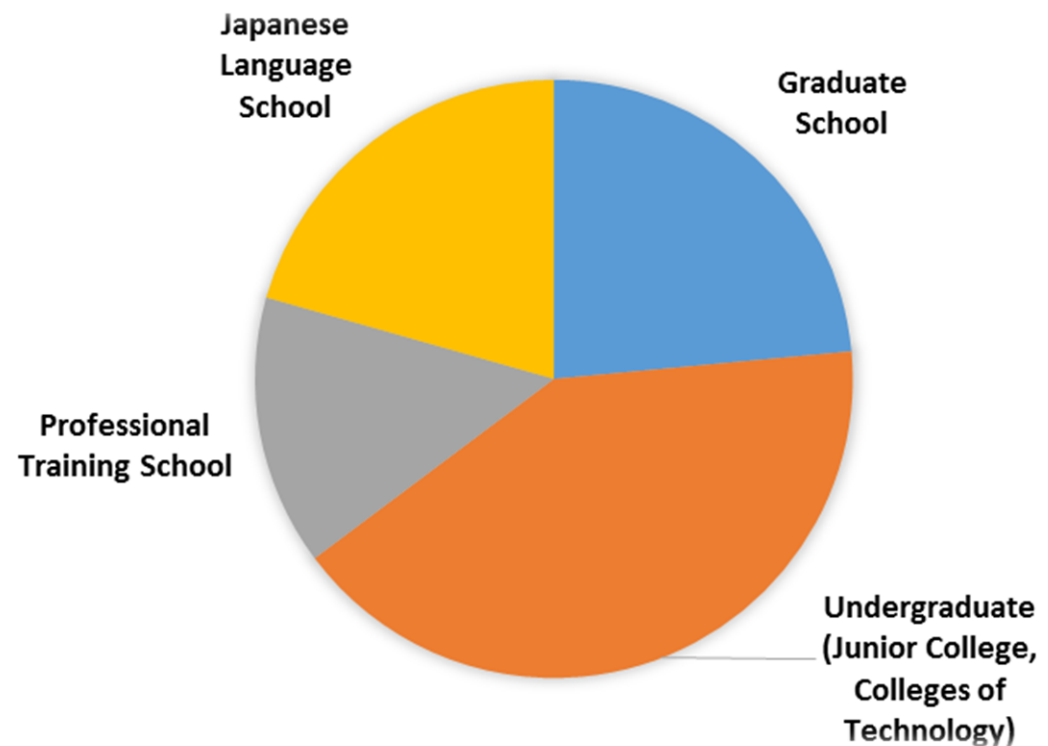

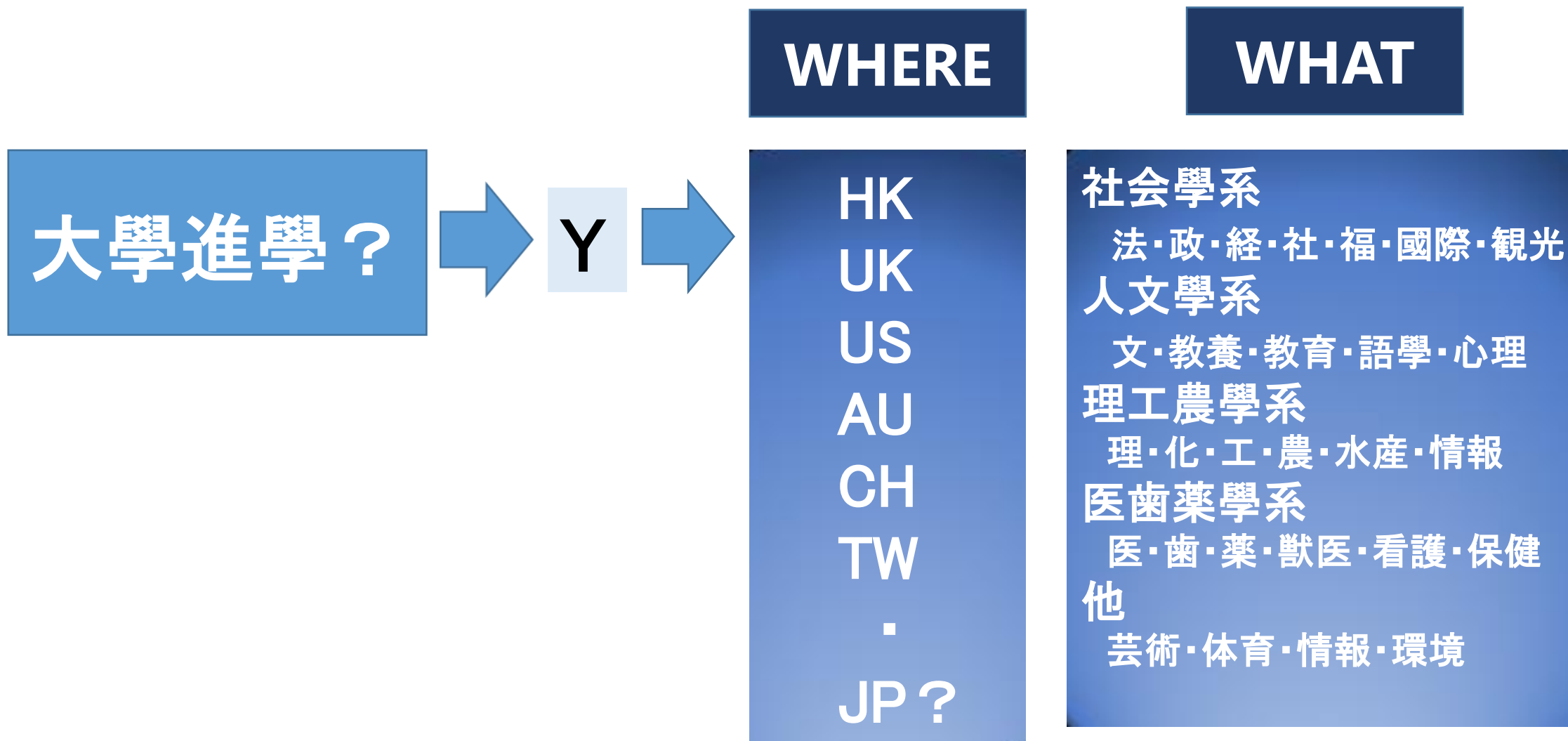

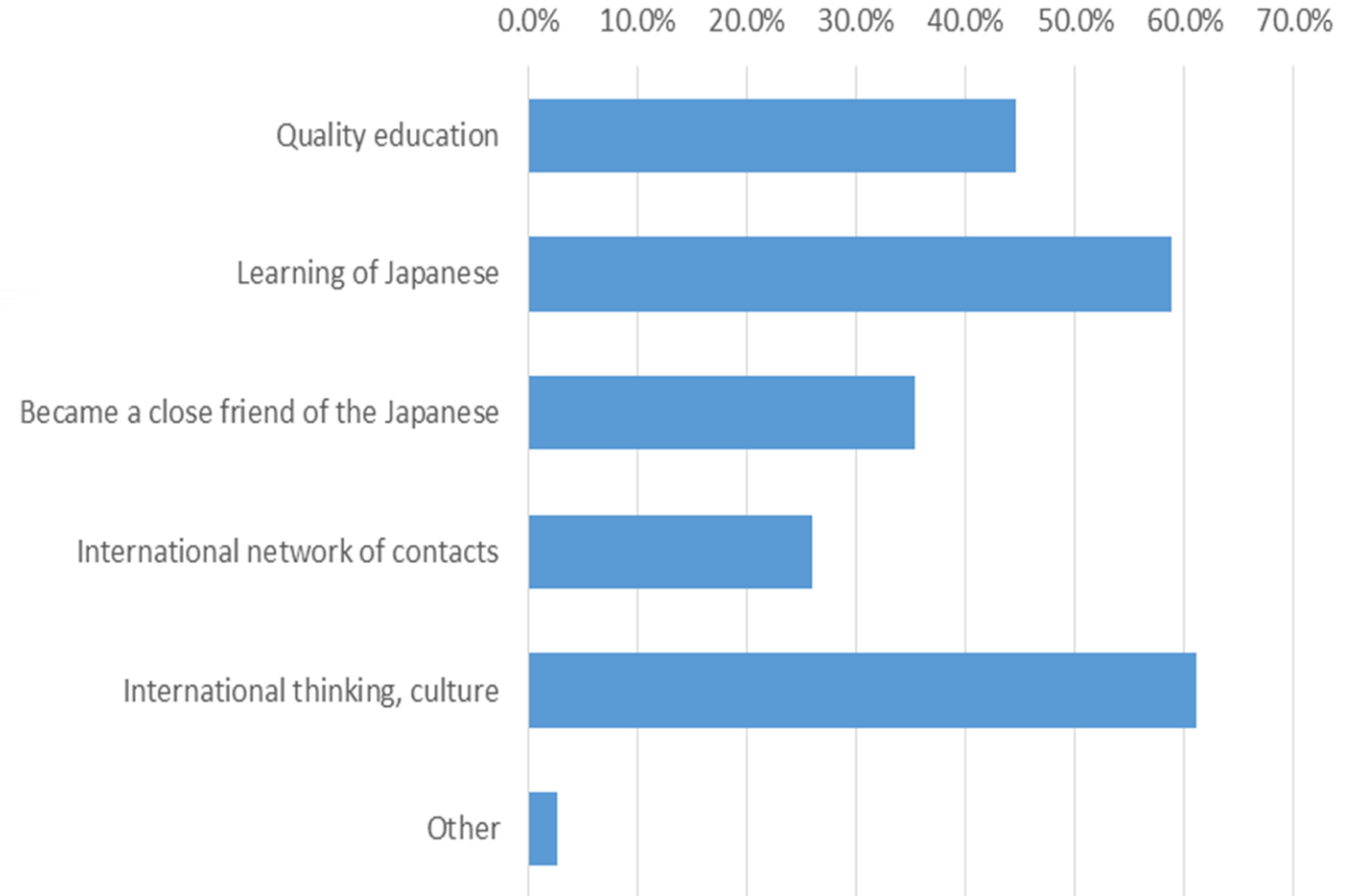
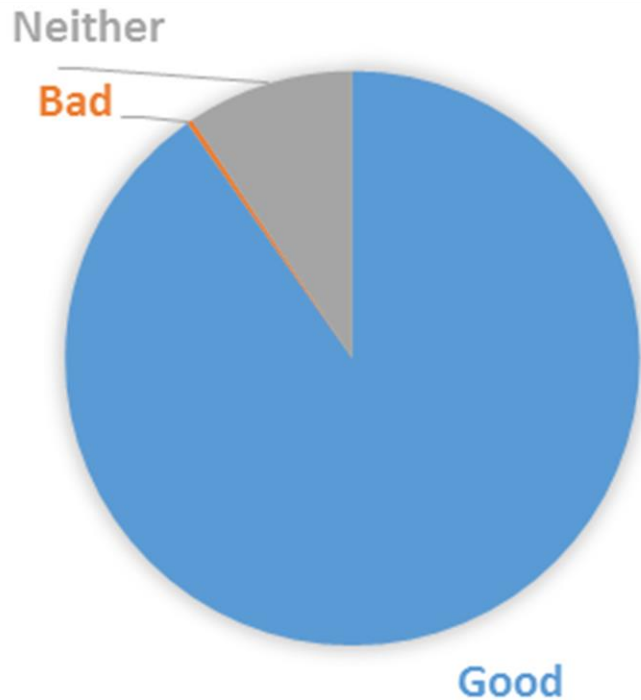


Process of Studying Abroad

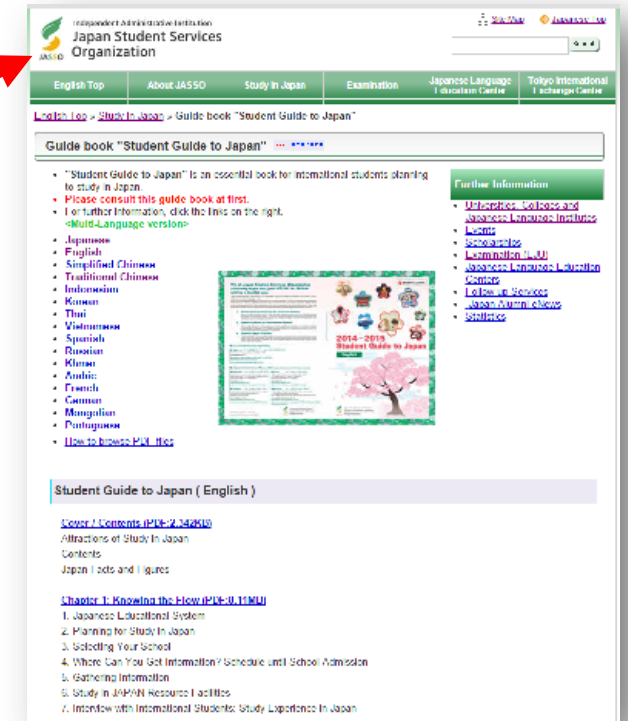
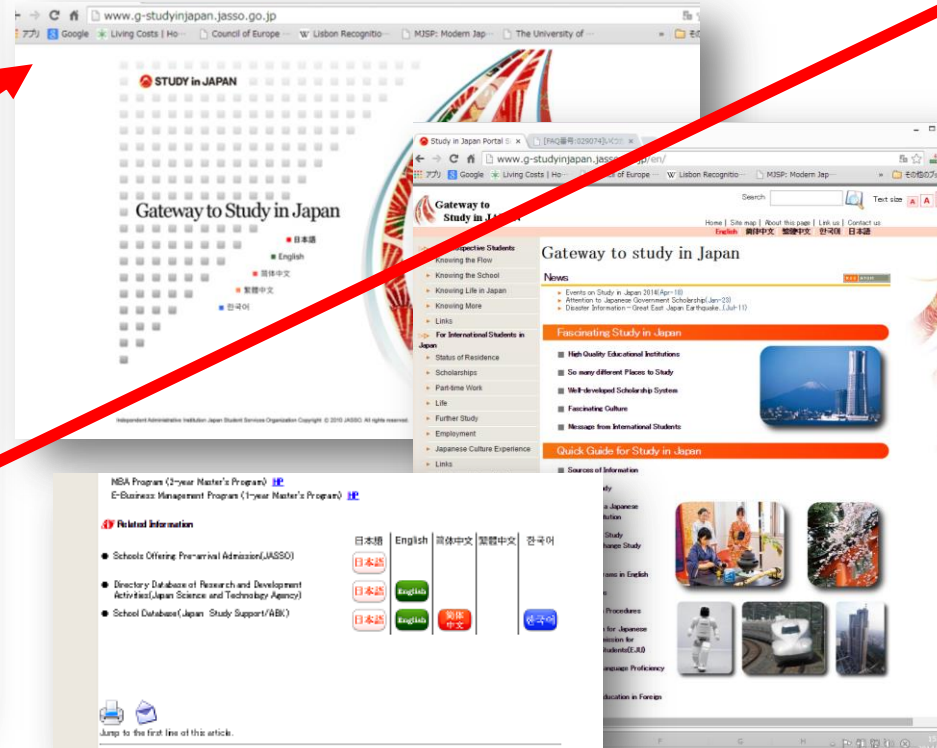
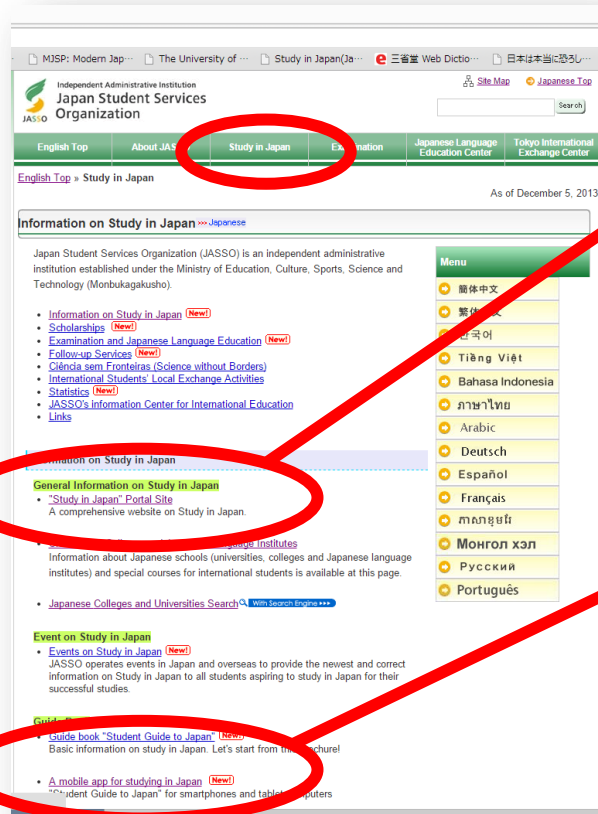
