All other subjects (including relevant Applied Learning subjects) will be given a weighting of at least 5. The following subject weighting will be adopted for scores calculation:
 - Core - 10 or 7
 - Preferred - 10
 - Others - 7 or 5
- Programmes which have specified the Extended Modules of Mathematics (i.e. M1 or M2) as subjects with the highest weighting, if the weighted subject score of M1 or M2 is higher than that of the "best weighted elective" under the "4X + 1" model, or the "last best weighted subject" under the "Best 5" and "Chinese + English + Best 3" models, the "best weighted elective" or the "last best weighted subject", and M1 or M2 will each carry 50% weight in the admission score calculation.
