

Korean Universities


• 43 National universities; 180 private universities

- Tuition and living costs substantially cheaper than U.S., UK, Australia




One Year Costs

Admission Requirements

- Proof of graduation from a government recognized secondary school - diploma
- Transcripts from the last 3 years of high school
- Language requirements differ among universities
- Majors in English language are offered in many universities

Student Employment


- International students holding valid student visas can participate in short term internships that are related to their studies






What is happening in Western Universities??

- Places of liberal thought and intolerant of other views (especially conservative)
- Polls show 72% of US faculty identify as liberal; opposed to 15% conservative
- Top universities: 87% liberal, 13% conservative
- Only 31% say they attend religious services regularly
- Liberal infrastructure prevents conservative professors being hired
