




#### **Good reasons for studying in Germany**



#### Foreign Nationals Studying in Germany in 2017

- Germany has more than 2.8 million students in total, 12.8% of them from abroad (appr. 360,000), figures rising.
- Most of these foreign students come from China, Eastern Europe or Western Europe.





- · Food, clothing
- · Leisure time activities
- Additional taxes and fees (see below for details)






#### **Working while Studying**

- Many students supplement parental support, student loans or scholarships with a part-time job.
- Non-EU citizens who do not have work permits may work for 120 full days or 240 half-days – more if they have jobs as student or graduate assistants.
- Whatever jobs they have need to be reported to the foreigners authority.








