- Primary and Secondary:
- Homestay: School Boards offer Homestay Agents and help students look for host families.
- Cost: CAD1000-1200/month, incl. 3 meals (Excl. Transport: bus they will usually arrange host families closer to the schools)
- Should there be problems, contact the school and provide details. Schools will handle accordingly (e.g. switching host families)
- Requirements of homestay families: Register with schools + visits from school representatives + non-criminal record + experience of hosting international students
- Some students these days may not be very self-disciplined, and host families can help regulate students' resting hours
- Weaker internet connection in Canada than in HK, so students may find it hard to play as much online games
- Universities: dormitory + optional meal plan for the first year. From 2nd year: most students rent their own houses
- Cooking their own food doesn't cost much (CAD300-400 per month would be enough)
- CAD10,000 per year (Sem ends in Apr, and students can then take summer school / take up summer jobs)
- Intl students: 20 hours working during term time. 40 hours during holidays
