Activities/ Programmes organized by The Hong Kong Association of Careers Masters and Guidance Masters Limited

Courses, Seminars & Workshops

Topics like JUPAS application, professional occupations, successful transition and multiple pathways for secondary school leavers, overseas studies, careers assessment tools, prevention of student suicide, crisis management and inclusive education are some of our recurrent themes. In 2020-21, despite the limitations posed to physical activities by Covid-19, a total of 11 webinars themed aforementioned were held. All the events were well-received. Apart from teachers, students and parents were invited to take the ease of joining the events online together, allowing us to reach a larger profile of audience.

Publication of Careers Guidance Handbook for Secondary School Leavers

A Handbook for secondary school graduates is published annually, in collaboration with Higher Education Division, EDB. The Handbook provides valuable information for them before the release of public examination results.

Research and Development on Individual Student Planning and Student Guidance

With the support of local academics, experienced careers teachers and CDI, two learning tools, "Finding Your Colours of Life" (for S.1-S.3) and "Career Mapping" (for S.4-S.6) were published for local secondary schools since 2007. Finding Your Colours of Life" and "Career Mapping" are widely used as the career and life planning curriculum for most local secondary schools. "Dreamcrafter 2.0" board game, "Occupation Card Sort" (Imagination of the Future of Work version), "Career Fingerprints: Exploring Skills and Styles" card sort, are the other career assessment tools developed with the job-effort of HKACMGM research team and local academics in recent years.

In 2020, we collaborate with Dr Mantak Yuen of the University of Hong Kong to establish LIFE+ - a comprehensive on-line survey on life skills, career development and various constructs on positive development of local students. Schools and secondary school students are given group-based profile and individual reports to facilitate understanding of developmental needs and individual guidance/advising.

Summer Career-Related Experience Scheme

The Scheme provides students from member schools opportunities to acquire work knowledge and interpersonal skills and to experience the actual working environment in safe working conditions covered by insurance. In summer 2021, the scheme was revamped into online training plus workplace visits, career talk and job shadowing at 18 different host organizations. About 260 workplace opportunities were provided for S.5 & S.6 students.

JUPAS Talk and Statistics, Electronic Learning Platform, DSE Results Release Resource Platform

JUPAS seminar with representatives from all JUPAS participating institutions has been one of the most well-received professional training seminars organized by our Association for more than a decade.

In 2020-2021, the Association has enhanced the JUPAS Statistics platform and we successfully collected over 12,000 real cases with JUPAS offers contributed by member schools. The data bank is by far the most reliable and informative resources for careers teachers and students' reference.

A resource platform has been established and integrated at our website to provide careers teachers, students and parents on various information related to multiple pathways and resource packages supporting students' transition needs at any time of the year.

Response to Education Policies related to Careers Guidance and Guidance

The Association has taken up an active role in response to various policies and voice the needs and concerns of front-line practitioners to various sectors. In view of the emergence of various reform measures which might have significant implications on the role and development of Careers Guidance and Life Planning Education and Guidance in secondary schools, from issues related to multiple pathways, policies on school guidance to the optimization of secondary school curriculum lately. Representatives of the Association are members in different liaison committees or advisory meetings to channel voices of the front-line counsellors to various parties.

Bio-sketch:

Justin Wu is the Associate Dean (Health Systems) of Faculty of Medicine, The Chinese University of Hong Kong. He is responsible for the development of collaborative network with private health systems, business and industry partners in Hong Kong, Greater Bay Area and beyond.

He is the former Chief Operating Officer of CUHK Medical Centre, the private teaching hospital of CUHK; the founding director of Asia's first "Global Physician-Leadership Stream" (GPS) of MBChB programme; and the founding director of Hong Kong Institute of Integrative Medicine with the mission of fostering cooperation between Western and Chinese medicine in the healthcare system.

He is an eminent teacher with 8 teaching awards of medical education, which include Vice-Chancellor Exemplary Teaching Award, Master Teacher, and Teacher of the Year Awards in CUHK Medicine.

Professor Wu also actively contributes to the development of medical innovations. He is serving as director and advisor of biomedical technology companies and investment funds.

Professor Wu is a professor of gastroenterology with academic focus in the field of functional gastrointestinal disorder and gastroesophageal reflux disease. He is serving leadership role in many local and international professional organizations, which include the President of Hong Kong Society of Gastroenterology, President of Asia Pacific Digestive Week (APDW) 2017, and President of Asian Pacific Association of Gastroenterology (APAGE).
