3.3.2 專業發展

3.3.2.1 學生輔導的短期課程

本會去年與基督教服務中心合作舉辦短期的輔導課程。期望透過經驗社工及資深老師的分享,讓前線老師能盡快裝備自己。這個課程深受老師歡迎,學員反應甚佳。

3.3.2.1《給守望者》計劃

- v. 2019-20 學年初,社會和教學環境面對沉重壓力,本會於短短數天內將大量資料組織、整理,製作「香港輔導教師協會:開學的輔導需要、支援及資源平台」(https://www.hkacmgm.org/?p=2667),將平台資訊分發予會員學校輔導人員,得到很正面的回應,普遍認同平台資料完備,能大大減省教師自行搜尋資源的時間。
- vi. 本會與香港精神科醫學院於九月初舉行了三場不同主題的工作坊,就前線最關注的課題(自殺、情緒、欺凌)給教師和青年工作者作基礎培訓,合共三百多人次參加,反應理想。
- vii. 《給守望者》計劃獲香港賽馬會慈善信托基金及香港教師中心分別贊助兩階段,印製資源於全港 474 所中學,總受惠人數超過四萬次;製作「守望小故事」一分鐘短片用十段及主題曲,推廣精神健康及正向情緒能量;舉辦「校園情緒教育:靜觀教師培訓」,分層(基礎培訓工作坊、到校支援)幫助學校輔導人員自我照顧、適時在校推動靜觀作為建立正向情緒的策略之一,約270 教師/輔導人員受訓,預計在學受惠學生人數可達二十萬。

3.3.3.3 myCareerMap 輔導評估工具平台

重新啟動 https://mycareermap.org/ ,與香港大學袁文得博士合作,建立一站式評估群體(學校、級)及個人化(中學生適用)生活技能、well-being、生涯發展及招擇影響因素的電子平台,推動學校輔導人員以數據為本(evidence-based),了解學生群體特質及需要,也作為給學生個人輔導諮商的實用輔助工具。

3.4 升學及就業輔導講座及工作坊

去年本會共舉辦了7個講座及工作坊給逾1127位老師、家長和學生。也與很多不同團體協辦講座和活動,如教育局、聯招辦事處、自資高等教育聯盟、職業訓練局、香港中央圖書館、香港女工商及專業人員協會等。
